**STAY ALERT

**Stay at least two metres
apart at all times**



**Follow public health
guidelines for hygiene**



**Do not attend if you show
symptoms of COVID-19 or
are self-isolating**



**Only touch your own
equipment (or equipment
on loan from the club)**



**Only one to one coaching
permitted**



**Pre-book a target
(where possible)**



**Come ready and leave
straight after you've
finished shooting**



**Only one person per target unless
shooting with someone from the
same household & stay in lane**



**Do not move targets unless
advised by a club official**

Archers please note the following:

- You will only be allowed to shoot according to the rules in the attached Risk Assessment and AGB notes to archers.
- Only shoot at a distance where you are confident of hitting the boss. Searching for arrows with a detector or with other archers will not be possible.
- Please confirm that you have read and understood the attached documents. If anything is unclear please ask.
- Initially the committee do not think a booking system will be necessary. However, should you arrive at the field and discover that all bosses are in use you must wait in your car for a lane to become free or return home.

- Apart from those altered by these notes, all other AGB Rules of |Shooting still apply (e.g. you must not shoot on the field alone.)
