Awards

Trophies will be awarded for 1^{st} place in all diciplines entered, with medels for 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place dependant on entry.

All Senior awards except prizes and medels will be held for one year or to the next Tournament, whichever is sooner and remain the property of Chorley Bowmen.

All Junior awards to remain propery of the winners.

An archer may take only one prize except in the case of Team awards and Lady/ Lord Paramount prizes.

A Raffle will be held at the end of the shoot before the Awards Ceremony.

Regulations

Entries will only be accepted from members of Archery GB and World Archery affiliated societies and membership cards must be produced at registration.

Juniors will be classed as any entrant below the age of 18 and can enter any of the rounds of equal or higher classification than that of their age group.

No entries will be taken without the Entry Form being submitted and accompanied by the correct entry fee. Refunds will not be made after the closing date.

Privacy

When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors, for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

In view of the provisions of the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs and video at this event are required register with the Tournament Organiser.

Directions from the North: Leave the M61 at Junction 8 and follow the signs to Chorley on the A6. Pass B&Q. McDonald's, Chorley Train Station and Morrison's and follow the A6 towards Bolton. Pass the Yarrow Bridge Hotel on the left and at the second set of traffic lights take the right turn on to the A5106 Wigan Lane to Wigan. Wigan Lane Playing Fields are approximately 1 mile away on the right.

Directions from the South: Leave the M6 at Junction 27 and take the A5209 towards Standish and Wigan. At the cross roads continue straight on towards Haigh and Chorley on the B5239. Pass under the railway bridge and at the mini roundabout turn left onto the A5106. Wigan Lane Playing Fields are approximately 3 miles on the left.
